Hardy Country and Kimball Hill off limits for logging. Gates may be needed at Province Road and Kimball Hill.

- ?? Bombardier is at Prinoth for service, it is complete and needs to be picked up cost of work done is approximately \$2,800.

Trail Administrator – Alan Barnard

- ?? Delivery of the new Tucker will be in December, payment needs to be made end of October. Picked up loan papers from Northway Bank they need to be completed. Total cost of groomer is \$162,249. The club will receive a trade in value of \$25,000, \$30,000 from the RTP Grant and Grant and Aid funds. The club also will be purchasing two new drags, total cost is \$28,356 we have received \$22,285 from an RPT Grant. For these two purchases we will need funds totalling approximately \$46,000. A motion was made and seconded to get a loan for \$20,000 the balance of what we need to come from club funds.
- ?? One of the old drags may be repaired and sold it is not worth trading we would only get \$500.
