- ?? Bodie gate holes need to be dug, so concrete can be poured.

Trail Administrator – Alan Barnard

- ?? Winter Grant and Aid signing was held this past Monday night; we have 700 hours and the fuel surcharge for this year.
- ?? Working with the Bureau of Trails to reallocated funds to help cover some of the washed out trails due to June rains, instead of the approved Summer Grant & Aid projects.
- ?? Bureau of Trails has approved an additional \$3,500 to assist with the washed out trails.
- ?? There is a possibility of transferring the approved RTP grant for Jewel Hill to Kimball Hill.
- ?? If the Orange Brook Trail is not plowed by January, it will be groomed.
- ?? We may be able to purchase poles from the power company for the bridges that need to be replaced.
- ?? We need two culverts, one for Ed Gempka's property and on for the Wisneski property
- ?? They will be logging the Hebron trail to the trail by Jay Matthews property.
- ?? Wagner wants to know the number of bridges and where they are in the future they need to be able to support the weight of the skidders, suggested portable bridges as a solution.
