- ?? Recreational Trails Program (RTP) Grant will be \$30,000 for the year 2006, the club can then apply for Grant and Aid the will cover 60% of the cost after the RTP grant. Applying for these grants will help replace the 1990 Tucker Sno Cat. Officers will get proposals on a new Tucker Sno Cat and a new Bombardier 180. Possible financing required may be \$15,000 to \$20,000 depending on cost and fund raising. RTP grant filing date is January 20, 2006. Motion made and seconded to proceed.
